Parking in Upton

Readers will be aware that parking through the town has become a major problem, particularly at Costa/Rowland's, Moorland Way shopping parade and outside the Triangle Shops.

These are all private car parks and are intended for the use of customers on a short stay basis only. They should not be seen as either 'park and ride' facilities, nor to park in one of them and 'shop' in another.

The Costa/Rowland's car park is clearly inadequate but this cannot excuse parking adjacent to the pavement/cycleway, which is clearly dangerous and illegal. As a consequence Parking Enforcement Services and the Police have been asked to monitor this area on a regular basis and to take any necessary action.

One major car park in the town at St Dunstan's/Community Centre on Poole Road is also a private car park and only available to the public through the goodwill of the Church officials.

The Town Council has tried to address another of the town's parking problems—parking on grass verges—by appealing to residents goodwill. Unfortunately this has met with little success, despite it being an offence under Section 137 of the **Highways Act.**

The Town Council will therefore embark on a programme in the New Year to prevent such parking through the installation of boulders or stakes, with the support of the Highways Authority.
