Upton Recreation Ground

I am sure that all residents will now be aware of the situation which occurred on Sunday 29 July when travellers broke onto our Recreation Ground off Sea View Road.

We were able to evict them very quickly because:

1. The designated Traveller Site in Piddlehinton had the capacity to take them—as part of Purbeck and Dorset (not the Poole/Bournemouth Conurbation) the rules of occupation are very different.
2. The Police authorised a Section 62a notice—this was processed on Monday 30 July AM and served later that day. This notice required them to vacate the site by 9 am on Tuesday 31 July. This notice states that they either go to the Piddlehinton site or they leave the County.
3. By 11 am on Tuesday 31 July the site was vacated.
4. By 4 pm the ground was cleaned and cleared.
5. Security measures on the gate have been reviewed and improved—and further security options are being investigated.

The Town Council wish to record their thanks to the very many people and agencies involved in ensuring that this process was carried out swiftly, and the guidance and support given throughout the process.
