It is with considerable regret that the Council has to announce that it has received the resignation of Mrs June Richards.

Speed Indicator Devices (SIDs)

Regretfully we have been notified by Dorset Council that they will no longer operate a SID scheme county wide, which means we will lose the one in Dorchester Road and Lytchett

The Town Council is looking into the purchase of its own SIDs, but due to the high cost involved, we need to look at funding options.



Self Help Community Sand Bag Scheme Launched in **Lytchett Minster**

Working in partnership with Dorset Council we have set up a new scheme in Lytchett Minster to help address their flooding problems. Sand and sand bag stores have been provided which local residents can access in the event of a concern about flooding.

The Town Council has a Flood Officer for Lytchett Minster: however would like someone from Upton to come forward to undertake this role in the town. No special skills are required, and support will be given.

Additionally, any resident concerned about flooding, should contact the Town Council and we will be able to raise your issue with a Dorset Council Flood Risk Officer. We also meet with them quarterly, as well as other officers within Dorset Council to discuss highways, parking enforcement, grass cutting and weed killing.


Climate Change
