Environment Update

Phase 2 of the installation of 'dragons' teeth on roadside verges has been completed along Dorchester Road, with further areas under consideration. A reminder to all that the grass

verges are officially part of the highway, and therefore come under the jurisdiction of Dorset County Council Highways department. The Town Council always seeks the relevant permissions from the landowner (i.e. DCC) before carrying out any works.

We are pleased to confirm that the grass bank at the top of Moorland Way has been improved with planting of trees, shrubs and bulbs—we believe it makes the area look much smarter and is a benefit to our fellow traders in the parade and for the visitors.

Moving forward, we are planning to create a wildflower area at Lytchett Bay View, which will increase the diversity and enhance the area. We are currently going through the legal process of establishing this area as an official Local Nature Reserve—we are very keen to protect this wonderfully diverse site. Please, if you have yet to visit—it is well worth it—great for families, dog walkers and it is accessible to all.
