The Town Council is pleased to report that we have recently been awarded just under £1000 from the Safer Dorset Fund to carry out some improvements at the skatepark near Warbler Close.

For some time young people using this area have been indicating that they would welcome a medium to express their art. Additionally, we have also received complaints about the condition of the underneath of the skatepark, which as it is not closed in, became a location for some less desirable activities.

The funding will be used to enclose the underneath of the half pipe, and then mdf boards will be secured, with young people being able to use these for their art work.

Periodically, we will paint the boards, and the art work can be renewed.

We hope that this will prove a positive facility for local young artists, as well as improving the appearance of the site as a whole.

Wildflower areas around the town are starting to flower. Great for our wildlife!
