Stick@30 Project—A local initiative to remind motorists travelling in our town to keep to the speed limit



Following complaints from locals about speeding in roads such as Sandy Lane, Dorchester Road and Poole Road, the Town Council applied for funding from the Dorset Police and Crime Commissioner to purchase wheelie bin stickers for bins (not garden waste) in those above roads.

Our Stick@30 Team (volunteers from the Town Council, Lytchett Minster and Upton Speedwatch Group, Partners and Communities Together (PACT)) and our local Safer Neighbourhood Team will be visiting those areas identified above in the next few weeks to distribute the stickers. Each resident will be issued with two; one for the recycling bin, and one for the waste bin. When you receive yours, please support this local initiative by taking 5 minutes to stick these to your bins. On collection days, these stickers will offer a very visual reminder to motorists to monitor their speed and 'Stick@30'. This scheme has become even more important with the news from Dorset County Council that the Speed Indicator Devices in both Dorchester Road and Sandy Lane will be withdrawn.

If this scheme proves to be successful, it is possible that we could roll it out to other areas of the Town where speeding is identified as a problem (subject to funding).

Please note, that all our volunteers will be wearing a 'Stick@30' label to identify themselves as bona fide.

If you are a resident of Dorchester Road, Sandy Lane or Poole Road and have not received your stickers by the end of February please contact the Town Council offices.
