## Defibrillator Updates



Firstly we are pleased to advise that a new defibrillator will be installed at the Community Centre, kindly funded by Poole Lions.

We will be shortly advertising awareness sessions to which all residents are invited to attend in order to learn how to use this life saving machine in the event of a cardiac emergency. Keep a look out on our noticeboards/website, or register your interest in attending via our Help Centre.

Secondly, we still need about four or five more volunteers from the Lytchett Minster Community in order to be able to establish a Village Emergency Telephone System (VETS). This is a register of local people who are prepared to collect the defibrillator and take it to the location in the village for use. Currently we have a few names, but not sufficient numbers to operate a successful scheme. Please contact the office if you live in the village and are willing to participate in this scheme.
