THE RECYCLING CENTRE NEAR UPTON OIL COMPANY, UPTON

We would like to remind residents that this facility is for **RECYCLING** materials and not for **DUMPING** unwanted items, which is happening currently. If this continues, our recycling facility at this location could be withdrawn.

Purbeck District Council has pledged to support the continuation of this facility, by updating and improving the signage and are closely monitoring the site. The District and County Council are also working together to improve the surface conditions, which will aid access to the bins.

The Town Council urges anyone witnessing abuse of this area by fly-tipping, at this location, or any other in our Town to report it to our Help Centre, or Purbeck District Council on 01929 557270, with a vehicle registration number if possible (reporting can be done anonymously).
