Services to local youth via Scouting

The Town Council was delighted recently to be able to nominate local man Niall Gordon as Volunteer of the Year for Lytchett Minster and Upton for 2014.

A special ceremony was held at Purbeck District Council to celebrate all of Purbeck's excellent volunteers.

Niall has been involved in the scout movement since 1975 when aged 8 he joined his local club in Upton. 39 years later he is now scout leader of 1st Lytchett Minster and Upton Scout Group, dedicating nearly all of his spare time to the young people involved locally in the Scout movement. He regularly takes the scouts away on adventuring holidays and camps. He regularly organises fundraising for the local scout group, and has obtained nearly £1000 from scrap metal collection.

Town Council Chairman, Cllr Mrs June Richards, who presented Niall with his award said 'it is great to be able to give this award to someone who has really made a positive impact on the lives of hundreds of our young people. I have nothing but respect and praise for him, especially so as he manages to balance all of his voluntary work with a full time career in banking'.

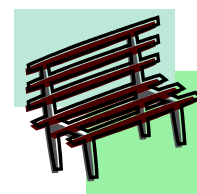
