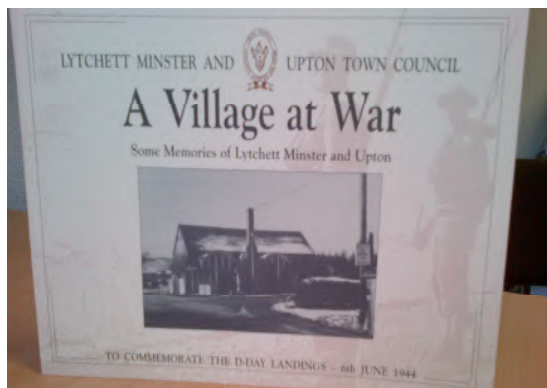
COMMUNITY CAROLS AT THE CROSSROADS
