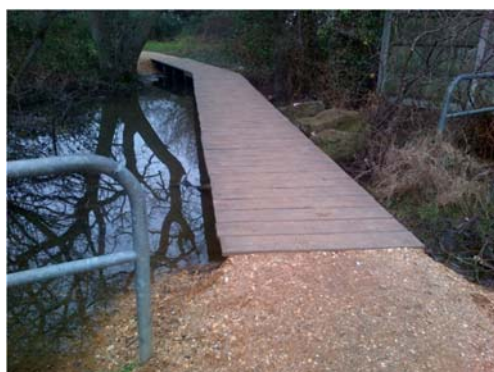

TOWN COUNCIL SOURCES FUNDING FOR 'BRIDGE OVER TROUBLED WATER'

Lytchett Minster and Upton Town Council are delighted to have been awarded nearly £5,000 of funding from Viridor to install a raised boardwalk at their local nature reserve, Lytchett Bay View. Historically, this important access route which links Upton to the Borough of Poole has suffered from flooding, which has hampered residents walking the area.

The Town Council, working in partnership with the Beacon Project (funded by the Big Lottery) who supplied the third party contribution, has installed a recycled plastic lumber raised pathway, so that this area can be accessed all year round. The sustainable materials used also have the additional advantage of being maintenance free and extremely durable. The work was undertaken by the Borough of Poole with some labour supplied by the Town Council maintenance team to reduce installation costs.



The Town Council has been overwhelmed with the positive feedback received from residents, and is pleased to announce yet another improvement for the town secured via the external funding route.
