DOGS NOT PERMITTED ON UPTON RECREATION GROUND.



The Town Council does not permit dogs on its Recreation Ground. Recently there have been a number of occasions when owners have ignored the signs at this site. There is a by-law preventing dogs (except guide dogs) entering the Recreation Ground, Sea View Road. This is primarily because this open space is used by local schools as their sports field, and therefore for health and safety reasons dogs have to be excluded. Please may we courteously remind dog owners not to walk their dogs here.
