## Greenridge Site—Latest News

You may be aware that Hall and Woodhouse had hoped that the building would be demolished by the end of March. This did not happen due to a last minute discovery of a gas main, which pushed the demolition date back to early April. At the same time, a bat survey was required, and although this revealed no bats in the roof, it did highlight some roosting jackdaws. As we understand it, no demolition can take place now until earliest end May or worst case scenario August/September. The date will depend on whether there are one or two sets of eggs laid by the jackdaws. Although frustrating for all concerned, adherence to the Wildlife and Countryside Act is important and necessary.
