Town Council Scores Again!



We are pleased to report that new safer goalposts have been purchased recently. This follows a successful funding bid to the Football Association, which means that 50% of the replacement costs have been granted to us.

We were awarded the grant after applying to the Football Foundation's Goalpost Safety Scheme. Since 1991 nine young footballers have tragically been killed in the UK by unsafe goals.

This new equipment for the Recreation Ground at Sea View Road is in addition to new tennis nets purchased recently, as well as the Multi-Use Games Area and Multi-Gym se-

cured in successful partnership working with Purbeck District Council.
