Viewing Mound to be Installed at Lytchett Bay View

A viewing mound will shortly be installed at Lytchett Bay View at the waters edge. This latest project at this special site is borne out of advice from Natural England who were concerned about people accessing the shoreline through the reed beds to observe wildlife and causing damage and disturbance. In addition it will enhance the visitor experience to access far reaching views across Lytchett Bay and ideal for local bird watchers. Funding has been successfully obtained from Awards for All (lottery) and Birds of Poole Harbour.
