Understanding Community Infrastructure Payments

Dorset Council will pass on 15% on CIL receipts for development in Lytchett Minster and Upton to the Town Council. This money gets paid to the Town Council twice a year.

The Town Council can spend this money on:

- Provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or
- Anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area

Monies generated from a certain area of the town do not have to be re-spent in the same area, it is for the Town Council to decide upon expenditure.

It should be noted that if the money is not spent within 5 years of receipt, Dorset Council may service notice on the Town Council to repay the monies.
