Dogs on Recreation Ground

It has come to our attention that the Recreation Ground is being used by owners walking their dogs.



THIS IS NOT PERMITTED, AND IS IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE 1990 BYELAW WHICH IS IN FORCE ON THE GROUND.

The Recreation Ground is a public space, which also serves as the playing fields to local schools—this is why the byelaw exists.

Anyone caught with a dog on the ground (except for assistance dogs) will be subject to a fine.

This situation will be monitored by Town Council Staff and the Dog Warden at Dorset Council has been asked to carry out random patrols, including early mornings, and late evenings.

Please respect this space—there are many other lovely areas to exercise our dogs, including Lytchett Bay View and the dog walking area to the rear of French's Farm.
