

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, VARIOUS ROADS, UPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:00 - 16:00 on 26th May 2026 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4th June 2026. The road(s) will be open outside of these times and also over the weekend.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on Moorland Way, Upton; Pinewood Close, Upton, Pinewood Road, Upton and Purbeck Close, Upton as indicated by signs on site.

[ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Moorland Way, Upton; Pinewood Close, Upton, Pinewood Road, Upton and Purbeck Close, Upton.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections. It is anticipated the closures will be carried out in two phases: [i] Moorland Way 26th - 29th May 2026; [ii] Pinewood Close, Pinewood Road and Purbeck Close 1st - 4th June 2026.
