

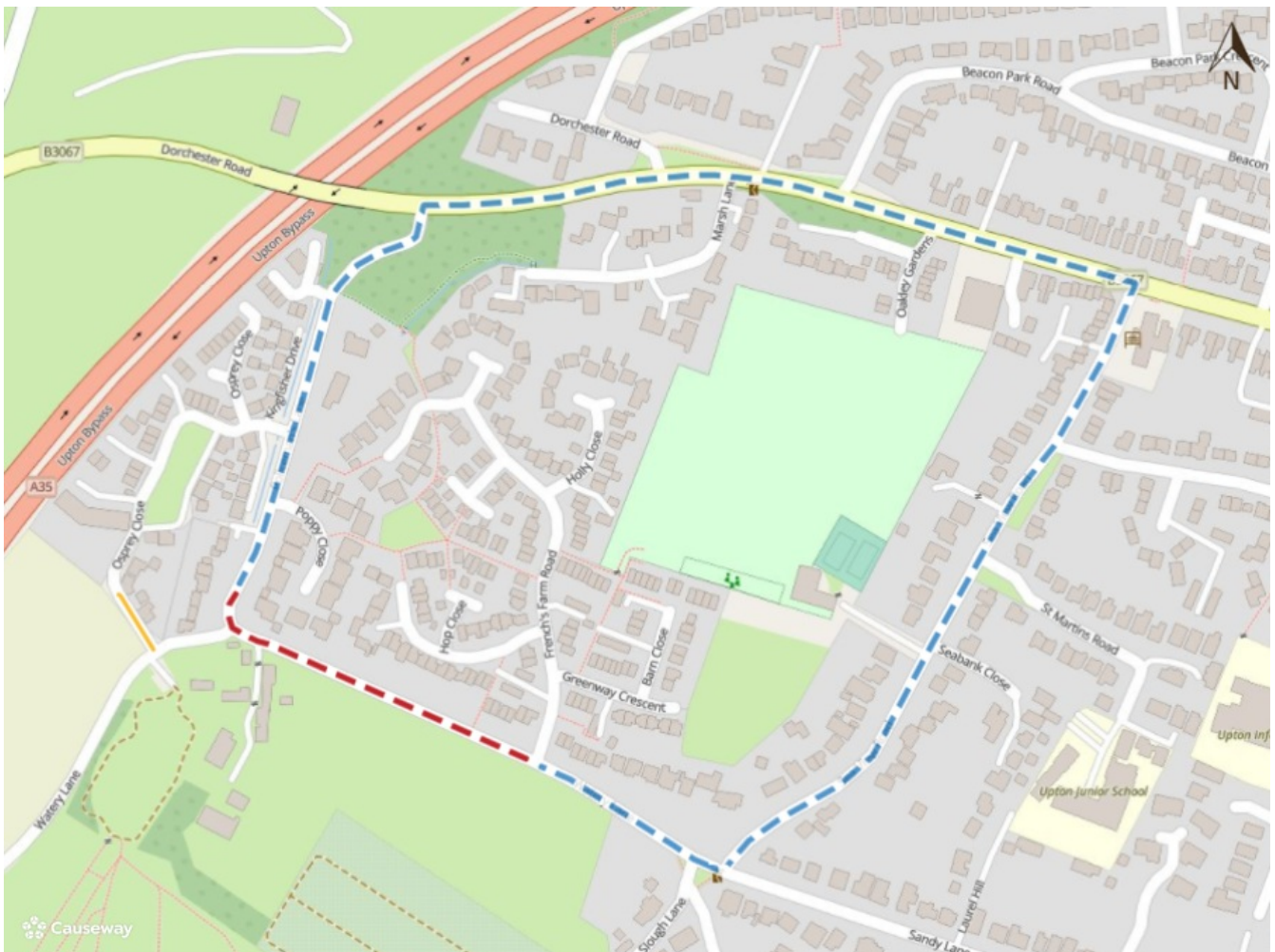

PROPOSED TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, UPTON

I have received an application from Brooklyn Homes Groundworks Ltd to close Various Roads, Upton as listed: [i] Policemans Lane between Watery Lane and a point approximately 50 metres north; [ii] Watery Lane between Frenches Farm Road and Policemans Lane. The closures have been requested to allow Brooklyn Homes Groundworks Ltd to carry out surfacing works. These works are programmed to commence from 1st September 2026 until 5th September 2026. In addition to the closures, Brooklyn Homes Groundworks Ltd have applied to revoke the one-way prohibition order on Osprey Close to facilitate temporary two-way access whilst the closures are in place.

Brooklyn Homes Groundworks Ltd will publicise the road closures in a number of ways: they will place information boards on the road in this area to inform the travelling public of the works; they will carry out a letter drop to local residents directly affected by the works; and they will sign a vehicular diversion route using the local road network. The following map shows the extent of the closures and the diversion route.
