

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, BLANDFORD ROAD NORTH, UPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 16th April 2026 between 20:00 and 06:00 and remain in force for five working days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21st April 2026.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on; Blandford Road North, Upton as indicated by signs on site.

[ii] To impose a temporary clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Blandford Road North, Upton.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
