

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, DORCHESTER ROAD, LYTCHETT MINSTER

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 10th August 2026 between 20:00 and 06:00 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 14th August 2026.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council safe access to carry out footway extension and pedestrian buildout to support highway improvements. It will also incorporate new surfacing and road markings (lining).

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on; Dorchester Road, Lytchett Minster as indicated by traffic signs on site between New Road and Access To South Lytchett Manor Caravan Park.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
