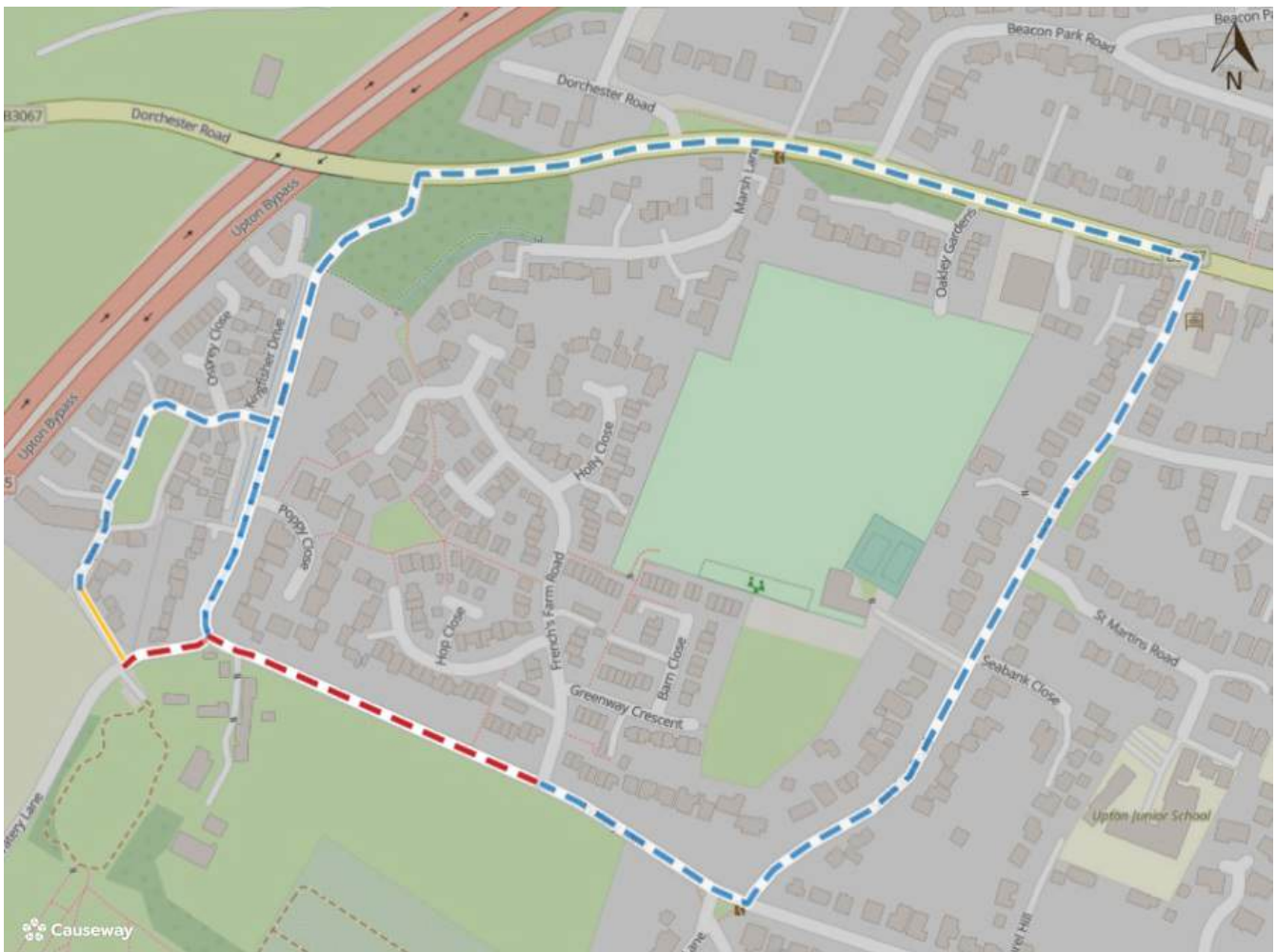


PROPOSED TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF WATERY LANE, UPTON

I have received an application from Mackoy Ltd to close Watery Lane, Upton in two phases as listed: [i] Closure of Watery Lane between its junction with Osprey Close and Policemans Lane from 26 May 2026 until 19 June 2026; [ii] Closure of Watery Lane between its junction with Policemans Lane and Frenchs Farm Road from 22 June 2026 until 26 August 2026. The closures have been requested to allow The Mackoy Ltd to carry out road widening, gully, kerbing and footway works. These works are programmed to commence from 26 May 2026 until 26 August 2026. In addition to the closures, Mackoy Ltd have applied to revoke the one-way prohibition order on Osprey Close to facilitate temporary two-way access whilst the phase [i] closure of Watery Lane is in place. Only one closure will be in place at any time.

Mackoy Ltd will publicise the road closures in a number of ways: they will place information boards on the road in this area to inform the travelling public of the works; they will carry out a letter drop to local residents directly affected by the works; and they will sign a vehicular diversion route using the local road network. The following map shows the extent of the closures and the diversion route.
