

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RANDALLS HILL, LYTCHETT MINSTER

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along Randalls Hill, Lytchett Minster at such times and to such extent as indicated by signage on site between Huntick Road and Pit Bottom, a distance of approximately 880 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 17th August 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4th September 2026.

This Order will enable Wessex Water Services to excavate in and across the road and verge to install a fire hydrant.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
