

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, UPTON BYPASS, UPTON (OVERNIGHT)

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 20:00 - 06:00 on 20th July 2026 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31st July 2026. The anticipated closures are between 20:00 - 06:00 as follows: 20th - 22nd July Westbound Full Closure. 22nd - 29th July Westbound Lane Closure. 29th - 31st July Eastbound Full Closure. The road will be open outside of these times and also over the weekend.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on Upton Bypass, Upton as indicated by signs on site.

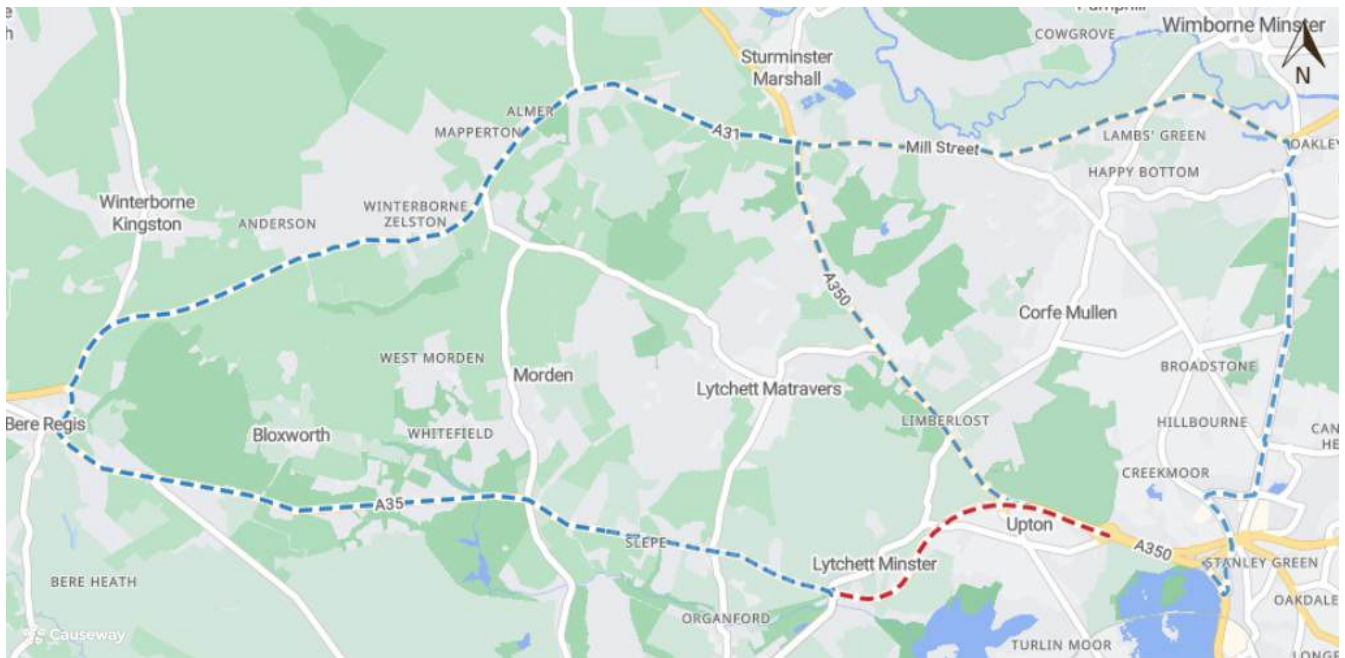
[ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Upton Bypass, Upton.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
