

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY SOUTHBOUND CLOSURE OF BLANDFORD ROAD NORTH, UPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding SOUTHBOUND along Blandford Road North, Upton between Upton Roundabout and Dorchester Road, a distance of approximately 560 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation with immediate effect and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26th July 2024.

This Notice will enable SGN safe access to carry out emergency works to a gas escape.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
