

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C60, MORDEN

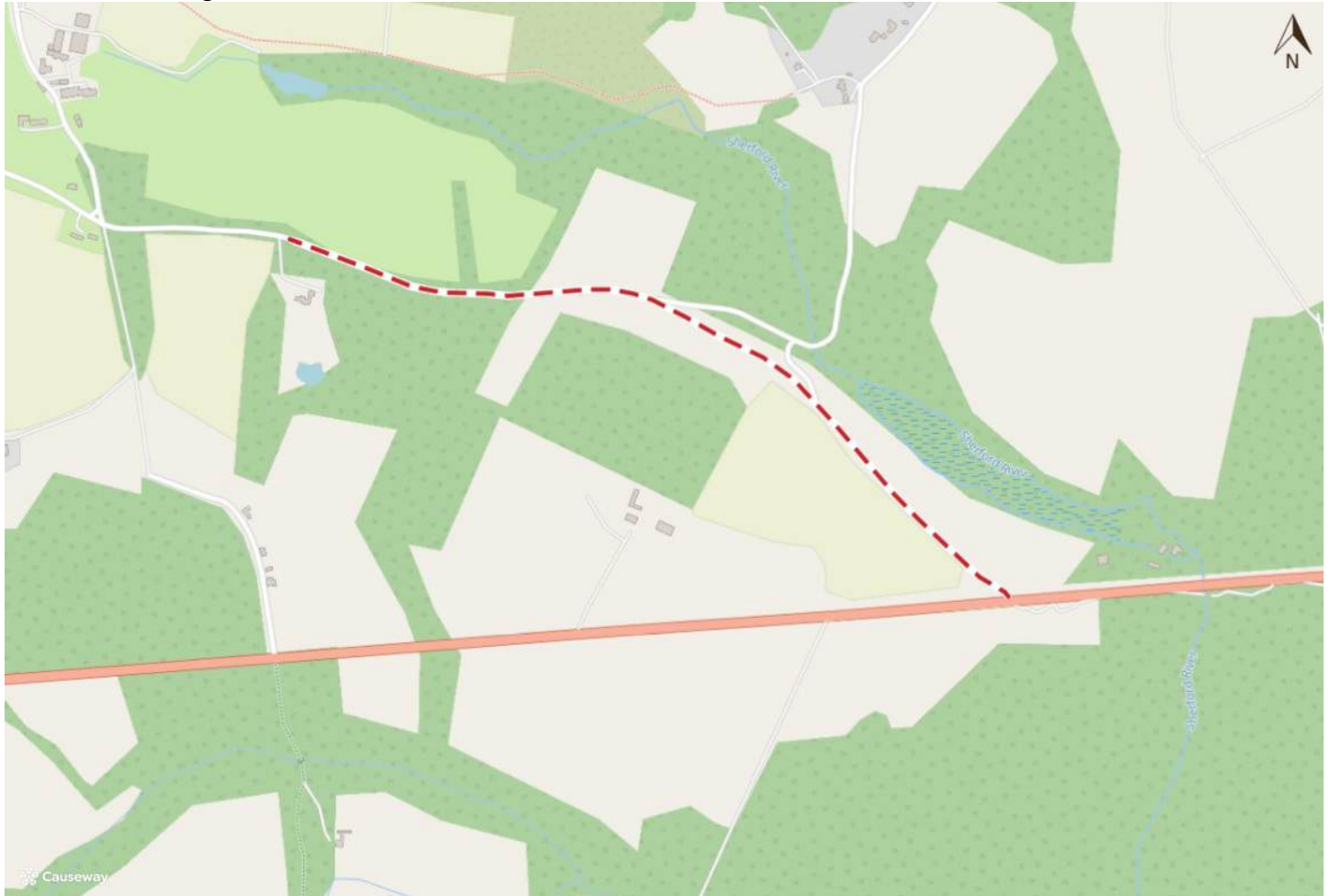
DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along C60, Morden from the entrance leading to East House, Bloxworth to junction with A35 (in both directions) a distance of approximately 990 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 23rd September 2025 and can remain in force for up to 21 days.

This Notice is required due to health and safety reasons being created by traffic avoiding official diversion and rat running through unsuitable roads.
