


Lytchett Minster and Upton Town Council

Consultation on the introduction of a 20-mph limit in Sandy Lane and associated roads.

The Department of Transport guidance states that 20mph schemes may have "environmental benefits as, generally, driving more slowly at a steady pace will save fuel and reduce pollution, unless an unnecessarily low gear is used."

Providing low speed in low traffic areas also promotes increased walking and cycling.
