



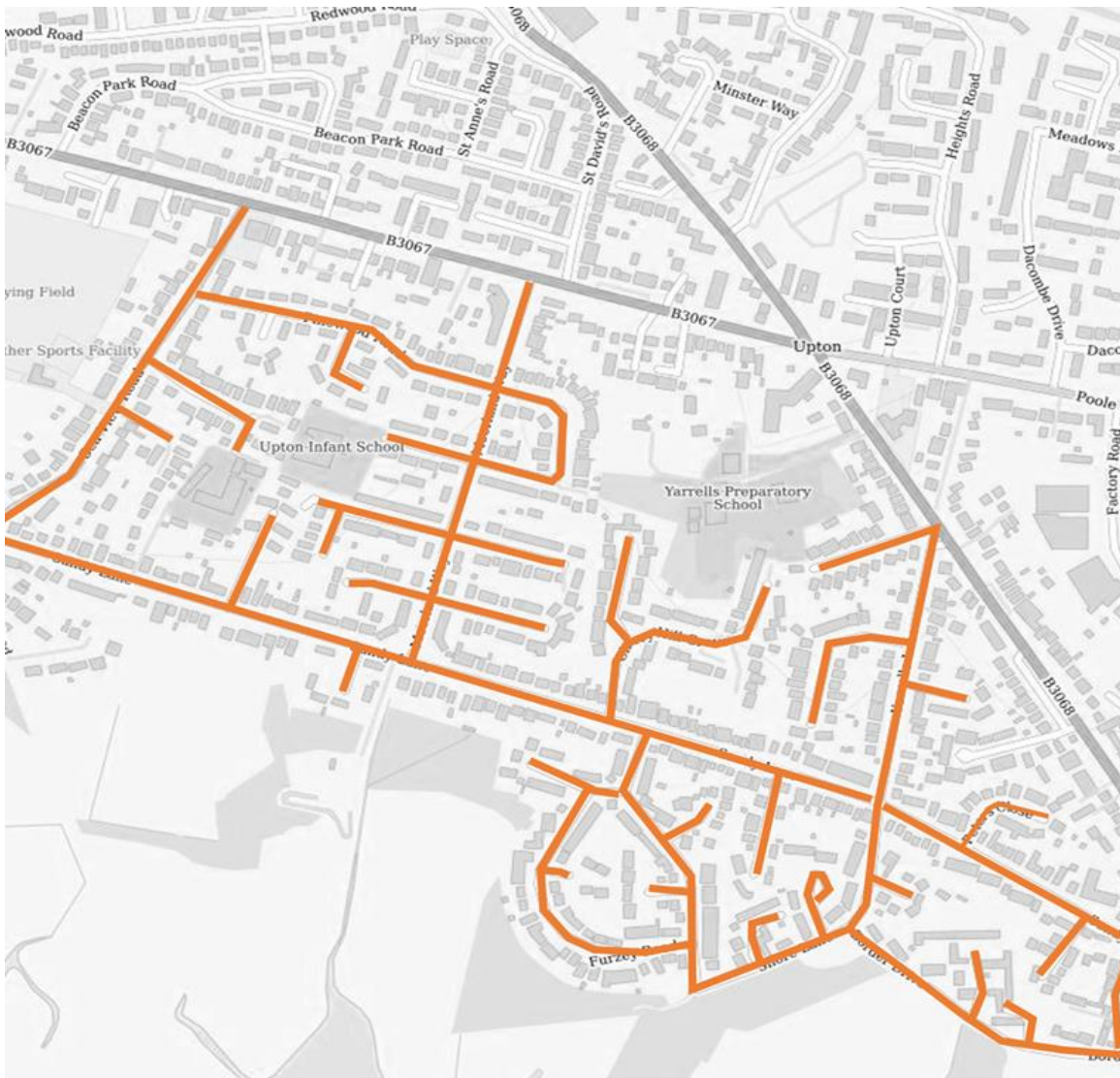
Lytchett Minster and Upton Town Council

Consultation on the introduction of a 20-mph limit in Sandy Lane and associated roads.

The Department of Transport guidance states that 20mph schemes may have “environmental benefits as, generally, driving more slowly at a steady pace will save fuel and reduce pollution, unless an unnecessarily low gear is used.”

Providing low speed in low traffic areas also promotes increased walking and cycling.

Map of Proposal (impacted roads marked in orange)



The proposed roads which will be impacted by the introduction of a 20-mph speed limit. You should also note that if this scheme is supported by local people, and taken forward by Dorset Council, it will include all roads leading onto these roads, as identified in the map.
