INCONSIDERATE PARKING

We all know that finding a parking space is becoming increasingly difficult but the Town Council is receiving a number of reports recently of inconsiderate parking on pavements and grass verges. It is an offence for a parked car to cause an obstruction to others, for example, by blocking a pathway. This can put pedestrians - especially those with disabilities or using pushchairs - in danger. It can also cause access issues for emergency services - with potential fatal consequences. The Town Council has raised these issues with Dorset Police, Dorset Council and the DVLA.
