TOWN FLOODING

Due to the amount of rainfall recently, certain areas of the town have experienced a lot of flooding. This is exacerbated by the Town's clay geology and the autumnal leaf drop preventing adequte drainage. Dorset Council operates a routine and reactive road sweeping programme. If you wish to report a road that requires sweeing, this can be done online via Dorset Council's website or contact the Town Council and we can report this on your behalf.



Sadly, anti-social behaviour continues to impact the town which has a negative effect on our community. Examples of anti-social behaviour include abandoned vehicles, graffiti and fly-tipping. Operation Relentless run by Dorset Police aims to tackle ASB hotspots. This is why it is so important to report all ASB witnessed in the Town so the police are aware and will increase their presence. This can be reported via Dorset Police 101 (phone and website) or via the Town Council. Always call 999 if there is a threat to life.
