

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, CHELMSFORD ROAD, UPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 16th September 2026 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 2nd October 2026 - 7th October 2026.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on Chelmsford Road, Upton as indicated by signs on site.

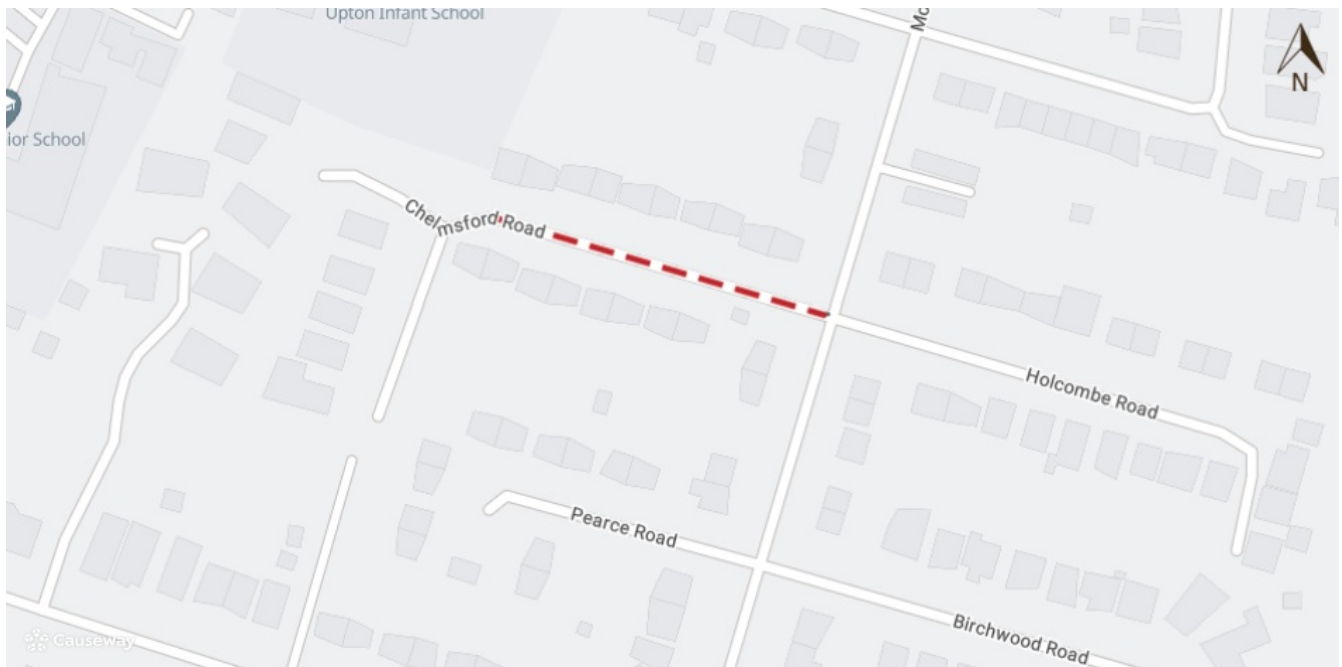
[ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Chelmsford Road, Upton.
