224/25 CORRESPONDENCE (PLANNING)

Correspondence from a Lytchett Minster resident and the Council for the Preservation of Rural England (Dorset), both regarding the local plan options consultation were considered and the contents noted.

225/25 TO REVIEW THE DRAFT LOCAL PLAN AND COMPILE A CORPORATE RESPONSE TO THE CONSULTATION FOR RECOMMENDATION TO FULL COUNCIL

The Committee had been tasked with leading on drafting a response to the consultation. Council had been successful in gaining an extension to the 13 October deadline and now had until 27 October to submit comments to Dorset Council. All members were encouraged to send their individual responses to the Deputy Town Clerk by 30 September so that they can be reflected in the final response. Members were reminded that Dorset and BCP Councils were consulting on a draft joint Local Transport Plan. The Mayor was formulating a response to this with input from a resident.

Members reflected on the initial advice provided by the planning consultant which had been very useful. Following careful consideration, key headings to form the basis of the Council's response were agreed and would be shared with all members, as follows:

Housing type and tenure – including affordable housing

What type of housing does our community need? Tenure, number of bedrooms, bungalows. Needs to meet the local housing need.

Sustainability using energy efficiently, conserving water, using renewable materials, reducing waste, and ensuring good indoor air quality

General Comments: i.e. lack of consultation drop-in session in LM&U. Inequity. Survey is not user friendly.

All comments would be compiled into a draft response which will be sent to the planning consultant for a technical review.

2. The United Reform Church building in Lytchett Minster had been placed on the open market to be sold with planning permission.
3. Members were reminded that the Dorset Council Ward Councillors would be hosting a public consultation drop-in on the Local Plan Options next Tuesday 30 September from 1pm in the Council Chamber at Moorland Parade.

234/25 TO REVIEW THE FEE FOR THE INTERMENT OF THOSE RESIDENTS, WHO AT THE TIME OF DEATH, WERE IN A NURSING/CARE HOME OUTSIDE OF THE PARISH FOR MORE THAN TWO YEARS

Members considered the request to revise fees for those residents who died in a nursing/care home outside of parish after more than two years. After discussion it was **PROPOSED, SECONDED** and **RECOMMENDED** not to adjust fees.

234/25 TO APPROVE MATCH FUNDS FOR NEW GOALPOSTS AT THE RECREATION GROUND AFTER SUCCESSFUL FA GRANT

Members congratulated staff who had submitted a successful application for new goal posts to the FA, with them awarding the Town Council 51.39% of new wheeled goal post costs.

It was **PROPOSED, SECONDED** and **RECOMMENDED** to fund the outstanding monies (£4,086) from the General Amenities budget to purchase this equipment. It was noted that although this budget had been set aside for youth provision, and whilst we continue to work towards bringing this service into the community, delays had meant it was unlikely to be achieved in this financial year, and so the monies to fund the goal posts should be used for this.
