

## **AMENITIES NOVEMBER 2025 - CLERKS REPORT:**

1. **Minute 516/24 Plans community and civic events** - See Agenda Item 6.
2. **Minute 192/24 To Review Future Burial Provision Within the Town and To Receive Any National Updates Regarding Policies to Address this Matter.** All remedial work from the independent survey has now been completed. The cemetery is still closed to new interments and will be revisited in the new year when we will have a better picture of the effectiveness of the drainage works. Plans and costs for a scattering area are being developed.
3. **Minute 49/25 To Receive And Approve The Hire Agreement With Poole Town Wessex FC For Use Of The Recreation Ground Pitches And Facilities** This arrangement is now in operation and working well.
4. **Minute 48/24 Youth Services In The Town.** Corfe Mullen Youth Trust will be reviewing financial options to extend their service to other towns, such as Lytchett Minster & Upton. Once the Trust has approved the service proposal, youth support service options will be shared with the Town Council and associated costs. Members will then need to consider whether they are justified to be included in next year's budget.

Councillors Griffin and Evans recently attended an event in Wareham to celebrate a successful summer for the Targeted Youth Team in Purbeck. It provided a valuable opportunity to meet the Targeted Youth Workers for the area. Cllr Griffin will provide a verbal update at the meeting.

5. **Minute 111/25 Upgrade to the Clocktower.** Smith & Darby has now completed the refurbishment and the Clocktower has regained its status as the Town's civic landmark.
- 7 **Minute 175/25 To Consider The Renewal Of The Allotment Management Agreement.** A meeting will be scheduled for the November meeting to commence discussions in preparation for the renewal in January 2026.
- 8 **Minute 234/25 To Approve Match Funds For New Goalposts At The Recreation Ground.** We have now formally accepted the FA Grant and have 6 months in which to purchase the goalposts. These will be purchased in the new year.
