

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, UPTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Various Roads, Upton as follows: [i] Beacon Park Road, Upton at its junction with Dorchester Road; [ii] Moorland Way, Upton at its junction with Dorchester Road. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It came into operation on 22nd July 2024 and remains in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 7th April 2025 and 25th April 2025.

**This Order will enable SGN to relay and decommission gas main.**

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
